

## JOINT TRAVEL REGULATIONS (JTR)

What are the Joint Travel Regulations (JTR)? They are the travel rules for Government Contractors set by the Department of Defense.

Federal Contractors generally follow the travel rules specified in the Joint Travel Regulations, which cover:

- Per Diem Rates Location is based on lodging location  
Meals and Incidentals Expense (M&IE)  
Lodging Rates, exclusive of taxes
- Travel costs in excess of per diem are considered unallowable (should not be billed against federal contracts)
- Differential for first-class airfare is unallowable
- Cost of alcohol, entertainment is unallowable
